Why not a single speed? My first bike had only the cassette and chain. I eventually got used to the derailleur, but always got a little annoyed when I had to push the chain back through the derailleur and down through the gears. When I upgraded to a single speed, it didn't seem right to have a different front chainring. I think I understand the benefit of having both gears, a smaller front and a larger rear, but I'm wondering if I'm missing something. Is there really any practical advantage to having two gears, and why did my first bike only have the front and rear chainrings? A: A single speed with two chainrings will shift easier than a derailleur one with one chainring, and the mechanics of the gears themselves will be simpler. In terms of the practicalities, there are two main reasons why having two chainrings is more useful: To allow a smaller front chainring, to keep the chain engaging with the chainrings for longer To change the size of the chainring to fit the gearing you are using. For example, if you go from 2x8 to 2x11 and the front derailleur is too wide to fit in the frame, you can remove the front chainring and fit a front chainring that is narrower. A: I think it may be that you misunderstand what a derailleur is. It is not there to retain the chain between the sprockets, it's there to allow you to change gears. And no, the chain doesn't actually engage the chainrings, it engages the front or rear pulleys attached to the front or rear derailleur which is also called the chain guide. All you need to do to get the chain onto the other side is turn the shifter, the derailleur moves, and the chain moves across. 2d92ce491b
